How to claim your SLSA Wales Tahdah Account

- 2. When you are asked are you already a member of Surf Life Saving Association of Wales please click YES (even if you are not a current member but have been historically)
- 3. Next enter your SLSA MIS membership number

MIS NUMBERS

MIS numbers have been amended the need for the extra zeros at the start of the numbers has been removed.

- E.G. RH018 has changed to RH18 RH07 / RH007 has changed to RH7
- 4. Fill in the remaining data

First name (as it is registered with your club eg Elizabeth, Lizzie, Liz etc) Your surname and date of birth.

5. You must agree to the terms and conditions before clicking next to complete this process of verifying and claiming your account.
